Author Guidelines

Thank you for considering the *European Journal of Social Science Education and Research (EJSER)* for your submission. EJSER is a multidisciplinary, open-access, peer-reviewed journal dedicated to publishing high-quality research in the social sciences, education, and related fields. To ensure a smooth submission and review process, please carefully follow the guidelines below.

1. Acceptance Criteria

To qualify for publication in EJSER, your manuscript must meet the following criteria:

- **Scientific Relevance:** The manuscript should address significant issues in the social sciences, education, or related fields.
- **Originality:** The work must present original research that contributes new knowledge to the field.
- **Interest to Readers:** The manuscript should hold broad interest for the journal's readership, including researchers, practitioners, and policymakers.
- **Quality:** The manuscript must be well-written, technically accurate, and adhere to ethical standards.

All submissions undergo a rigorous **double-blind peer review** process. For more details on the review procedure, please refer to the **Review Procedure** section on our website.

2. Content Categories

EJSER welcomes the following types of submissions:

- **Research Articles:** Empirical or theoretical studies that present original findings.
- **Review Articles:** Comprehensive reviews of existing literature on a specific topic.

- **Case Studies:** In-depth analyses of specific cases relevant to the journal's scope.
 - **Book Reviews:** Critical evaluations of recent publications in the field.
 - **Conceptual Frameworks:** Theoretical contributions that propose new models or frameworks.
 - **Technical Notes:** Short articles focusing on methodological or technical innovations.
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3. Subject Areas

EJSER encourages submissions across a wide range of topics, including but not limited to:

- **Social Sciences and Humanities:** Collective behavior, communication studies, culture and society, disability and integration, family and marriage, identity and globalization, social psychology, and gender studies.
- **Education:** Educational administration, policy, pedagogy, curriculum, online education, teacher education, and the sociology of education.

4. Manuscript Preparation

To enhance the quality of your manuscript, ensure it meets the following criteria:

- **Technical Accuracy:** All data, methods, and findings must be accurate and reproducible.
- **Originality:** The manuscript should not have been published elsewhere or be under consideration by another journal.
- **Referencing:** Properly cite all sources using the **APA Referencing System** (7th edition).

- **Structure:** The manuscript should be well-organized and include the following sections:
 - Title
 - Abstract (150–250 words)
 - Keywords (5–7 words)
 - Introduction
 - Literature Review
 - Methodology
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - References

- **Clarity:** The manuscript should be written in clear, concise English. Non-native English speakers are encouraged to seek professional proofreading before submission.

- **Length:** The manuscript should not exceed **6,000 words**, including references, tables, and figures.

5. Submission Process

6. Article Processing and Publishing Fee (APC)

A fee of **€220** is charged for processing and publishing each accepted article. Payment methods will be specified on the invoice issued upon acceptance.

7. Open Access Policy

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- The full text of published articles is freely available for noncommercial use.
- Users may download, distribute, and adapt the work, provided proper attribution is given to the original author(s) and the journal.

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8. Review Procedure

All submissions undergo a **double-blind peer review** process. For detailed information on the review procedure, including reviewer criteria and recommendations, please refer to the **Review Procedure** section on our website.

9. Publication Deadlines

EJSER is published four times per year according to the following schedule:

- **1st Issue (March)**: Submission deadline – 28 January
- **2nd Issue (June)**: Submission deadline – 28 April
- **3rd Issue (September)**: Submission deadline – 28 July
- **4th Issue (December)**: Submission deadline – 28 October

Late submissions may be considered at the editors' discretion, subject to an additional fee.

10. Ethical Considerations

- **Permissions:** Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to publish any third-party material included in their submission (e.g., photos, documents, datasets).
- **Authorship:** All authors listed on the submission must consent to be identified as authors and approve the final version of the manuscript.
- **Ethical Approval:** Research involving human subjects must be approved by an appropriate ethics committee and comply with the legal requirements of the study's country.

11. Checklist for Submission

Before submitting, ensure your manuscript meets the following criteria:

- The title is concise and descriptive.
- The abstract is self-contained and summarizes the key points of the manuscript.
- The manuscript is well-structured and adheres to the specified formatting guidelines.
- All references are cited in APA style (7th edition).
- The manuscript is free of plagiarism and has not been published elsewhere.
